- Balance - \$44,782.42
- Scholarship \$900.
 - There were 12 applicants. Committee was formed to go through applicants. 6 students awarded \$150.

- Ice Cream Social \$593 (expenses have not been submitted yet)
- Paid for 6th grade field trip (Franklin Institute), spent a little extra
- Parent Son Event, Ice Skating, spent \$26 (budget to spend \$150)
- Mr. Macosko spent money in Principal's Discretionary Fund on snacks for Homework Club
- Paid for Yearbook. We have sold 291, need to sell 334 to break even. Once books come in, we will sell the remaining amount for \$20. Usually sell out.
