

Hello Parents!

We hope this information finds you and your family enjoying your summer! This communication is to inform you of details regarding "All Things Chromebook" for the upcoming school year. Please review the information below so that you and your child(ren) can prepare for the 19-20 school year and their entry into our Digital Learning program.

Chromebook Distribution & Pickup Details

Students in Grades 6 and Newly Registered Students in Grades 7-12

- Chromebooks will be available for pickup on **August 13th**.
- **Distribution will be held from 8:30 am to 7 pm.**
- All distribution will be held at **North Penn High School**. *Please park in **Lot A** (go to the back of the building between the high school and bus garage) enter through **Door #A1**.* Signs will be posted to assist you in the proper door for pick-up. Due to cleaning, walking through the school from the front entrance is discouraged.
- The Chromebook Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) fee of \$26 is due on or before distribution. In order to expedite your pickup time we recommend using the preferred online payment method prior to August 13th - [click here for payment website](#). Please note that Chromebooks will not be distributed without payment of this fee. Remember to bring your online payment receipt (an electronic, email receipt via cell phone is acceptable). - **All students must be present for pick-up.** If High School students are picking up without a parent, a proper ID will be required.
- The distribution process will take approximately 15-20 minutes.
- If students are unable to pick-up their device on August 13, it will be distributed to them at their building, on the first day of school, as designated by your child's building principal.

Parents of 6th Graders who also have returning students in Grades 7-12:

Chromebooks should be charged and ready to bring to school on the first day of school.

As a reminder for all parents, student Chromebooks are filtered on and off our district network. You should be receiving a weekly report from Securly with your child's activity. This report will only come if there is activity. Additionally, it only reports off-campus activity, which, during the summer months would include daytime, evening and weekend activity. During the school year, this report only includes before and after school, evening and weekend activity. For parents of incoming 6th graders, this report will begin delivery to your email on August 15, 2018 (it comes weekly on Wednesday evening).
